



SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM LOCATION CHANGE 2019/20 FAQs

Will my child's Individual Education Program (IEP) be impacted?

No. Your child's special education service as written in his/her IEP/ARD will not change. Only the program campus location will change.

Will my child's special transportation services be affected?

No. Your child's special transportation services will continue as documented in the IEP/ARD.

If your child does not currently receive special transportation services and you do not live in the program campus' attendance zone, your child will be eligible to receive special transportation services in order to obtain access to the program location. If you choose to take advantage of this service, an ARD will be held to discuss the need for special transportation as a related service.

Is an ARD meeting required to discuss the relocation of the program?

No. An ARD meeting is not required. If you would like meet the teacher and ask questions about the classroom, contact the campus to schedule a parent/teacher conference.

If you would like to make changes to the IEP/ARD, contact the campus diagnostician to discuss those changes and what will need to happen to make those changes.

An amendment to the IEP/ARD will be completed to document campus location. You will receive a phone call from the campus diagnostician to discuss the IEP/ARD amendment and a copy of the IEP/ARD amendment will be provided to you.
