

## ***FAQs – Frequently Asked Questions for Beaumont United parents***

- Will my child receive a new schedule?

Yes, due to our two new master schedules we are completing, students will receive new schedules. Of course, our goal is to keep our students with the same teachers if possible, as well as the same electives; however, there may have to be some elective changes.

- How will the missed instruction be rectified?

The Curriculum & Instruction department is working to compact the curriculum for all content areas, along with adjusting testing calendars for the students at Beaumont United. More information regarding curriculum and assessment is forthcoming.

- Will my child still be able to participate in athletics?

Yes, students will still be able to participate in athletics. Accommodations are being made for students who participate in athletics with regards to transportation.

- Will transportation be provided?

Yes, normal transportation will be provided for students, as well as students who participate in athletics, i.e. needing to be transported from the ninth-grade campus to the 10th through 12th grade campus for after-school, as well as athletic periods.

- Will students be required to make up days missed?

We will await further guidance from our district-level administration and the state to determine if students will be required to make up days and how many. We are in the process of proactively planning for interventions and remediation to close gaps and make up for time lost to ensure our students are successful.

- Where will the specific Special Education Beaumont United programs attend school?
  - The BU Academics for Life students (teacher: Mayhall, Solleder, Durall, or Baker) will be attending ECHS at the Austin Innovation Center starting Oct. 14.
  - The BU Structured Learning Class with teacher Fontenot, will be going to ECHS at the Austin Innovation Center starting Oct. 14.
  - The BU Behavior Transitional Class – 9<sup>th</sup> Grade – will be attending the 9<sup>th</sup> grade (teacher: Boutte) campus at South Park location;
  - 10, 11, and 12 grade BU Behavior Transitional Class (teacher: Bevil) will stay at the Beaumont United campus.
