



Beaumont ISD Student Process Map for Close Contact/Exposure to COVID-19

Student or Parent reports Student has been in close contact* with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 (includes someone in Student's home).

Student should contact his/her primary care physician for guidance and remain home to quarantine and avoid public spaces for 14 days.

Staff and students are not contacted. Notice is only provided after receipt of lab confirmed positive test for COVID-19.

If Student ultimately tests positive for COVID-19, he/she will be required to quarantine until the re-entry criteria below are met.

-at least one day (24 hours) has passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medication);
-improvement in symptoms; and
-at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

Student or Parent reports someone in the student's home was **exposed** to someone who tested positive for COVID-19 or is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19

If the individual who was merely "exposed," without a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19, Student may still come to school.

***Close contact** is defined as:

1. being directly exposed to infectious secretions (e.g., being coughed on); or
2. being within 6 feet for a cumulative duration of 15 minutes.
