Dear Student and Parents/Guardians:

Regina-Howell Elementary School is selecting 4th and 5th grade students for the Student Ambassador Board for the 2022-2023 school year. Student Ambassadors are expected to be leaders on Regina's campus. They will be assisting walking new Kindergarten students to classes the first few weeks of school. They will help greet visitors, welcome new students, and show them around campus. Ambassadors may also be called upon to help give visitors a campus tour. Student Ambassadors will assist with some of the following events such as Running Start, Grandparents Day, Veteran's Day, after school programs, and other campus-based activities. In addition, Ambassadors will rotate working as office aides, sign & flag duty, morning door duty/welcoming students to school, must attend monthly meetings (schedules for meetings will be given out over the summer), and participate in two community service projects. Ambassadors will also be asked to create posters for various activities throughout the school year to place around the school.

Selected students must demonstrate a willingness to help others, they are expected to be on time, independent, responsible, have a desire to develop their leadership skills, maintain acceptable grades, and have appropriate conduct in the classroom and other areas of the school or school sponsored events. Schedules will be sent out by Class Dojo on a month-to-month basis.

If academic or behavioral problems arise during the school year, student privileges may be limited, including, not participating in activities or they will be removed from being a Student Ambassador.

Students currently in the 3rd and 4th grades who are interested in becoming a Student Ambassador must complete the entire application.

The completed application is due by Friday, May 18th, 2022. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

The selection committee will base their decisions on the following: grades, reference input, conduct, attendance, and student essay. If chosen, students will be notified by the week of June 1st by their school email from the selection committee. Google Classroom and Class Dojo codes will also be sent out to new members, and communication will be sent out for beginning of the year events. Ambassadors will have the opportunity to order an Ambassador shirt if they chose to closer to the beginning of the school year. Photos and ordering information will be posted in Google Classroom.
